From teaching art as a vocation to pursuing art as an avocation, the eight artists have embraced their passion most of their lives and their works represent myriad styles, a range of mediums including oils, watercolors, acrylics, mixed media, encaustic, charcoal, pencil and photography, and a variety of subject matter. The artists have won awards, been featured in numerous juried, group and solo exhibitions and have many of their works in private collections.

Ed MacEwen, art chairman for the library remarked, "Our Summer Show lets us peek at the works of many wonderful artists. This exhibition gives us a chance to see more from this talented group of painters and creators, all of whom have some sort of connection to Wilton, past or present."


