Wilton Library and Western Connecticut Health Network Health Literacy Series

The Skinny on Skin Cancer at Wilton Library May 23

Wilton, CT – “The Skinny on Skin Cancer” is the next topic in the “Get Well, Stay Well” health literacy series presented by Wilton Library and Western Connecticut Health Network. The program will take place at Wilton Library on Tuesday, May 23, at 7 p.m.

The featured speaker is Steven A. Kolenik, III, MD, dermatologist on the Medical Staff of Norwalk Hospital. Dr. Kolenik is in practice with Connecticut Dermatology Group and is an assistant clinical professor of dermatology at Yale University School of Medicine. He will address skin cancer prevention, including risk factors, symptoms, screening, diagnosis and treatment. Dr. Kolenik will also explain the different types of skin cancer. His presentation will be followed with a question and answer session.

Dr. Kolenik graduated Phi Beta Kappa with a Bachelor of Science’s degree from the University of Pennsylvania. He received his doctorate from Yale School of Medicine, where he also completed his post-graduate training in dermatology. He also served as Chief Resident in Dermatology at Yale and completed his fellowship there in Mohs micrographic surgery. Board certified in dermatology, Dr. Kolenik is a member of the American College of Mohs Surgery and Cutaneous Oncology. His memberships include the American Academy of Dermatologic Surgery, the Connecticut State Medical Society, for which he served as a former secretary and president, as well as the Fairfield County Medical Association.

The health literacy series is moderated by Saras Nair, MD, former chairman of the Department of Pathology at Norwalk Hospital and a trustee of the Wilton Library Association.
