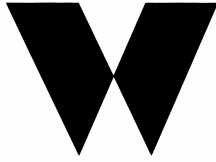

#### **Wilton Library annual meeting set for June 15**

Wilton, CT – Wilton Library Association's Friends of Wilton Library will conduct its 113<sup>th</sup> annual meeting on Sunday, June 15 at 4 p.m. in the Brubeck Room. The meeting, which is open to the public, will be followed by a reception. The guest speaker is architect Frederick Noyes, son of the late Eliot Noyes, architect for the building constructed in 1975, on which the new expansion is based. Mr. Noyes will address Modern architecture, the geometries associated with it, and the future of modernism. The meeting also will cover the election of officers for the Board of Trustees, along with recognition of volunteers, staff and retiring board members. This year's proposed slate of officers is Louise Herot, president; Howard Greene, vice president; Patricia Clifford, secretary and Holly Sexton, treasurer.

An added attraction to this year's meeting is the announcement of the Wilton Reads! book selection. This is the fourth year for the community-wide Wilton Reads! program that features free books to patrons, day and evening book discussions and film screenings, culminating with the author's talk at the library. A limited supply of books will be distributed at the annual meeting, with more books to be given out this fall. This year's Wilton Reads! event is funded in part by a generous donation from The Wilton Bank.
