Wilton Library's 114th annual meeting June 14 with Exit 43

Wilton, CT – Wilton Library Association's 114th Friends of the Library annual meeting takes place on Sunday, June 14, beginning at 4 p.m. with a general business meeting and then a performance by the musical group, Exit 43.

The meeting includes the election of a new slate of officers for the Board of Trustees. The candidates are Judy Higby, a former president of the board ('01 – '04) now nominated for president, Whitney Janeway for vice president, Holly Sexton, current treasurer of the board being nominated for secretary, and Greg Jansen for treasurer. Retiring board members will be honored with books in their names that will become part of the library's collection. Additionally, a volunteer and a staff member will be recognized for their efforts this year.

Following the business portion of the meeting, the musical group, Exit 43, a rock/gospel/folk acoustic band will perform. The group is comprised of Wiltonian Andy "A.J." Gundell (vocals, guitar, harmonica), songwriter, singer, composer and winner of 13 Emmy Awards and a resident of Wilton; Scarlett Lee Moore (vocals and percussion), international blues performer, twice voted Fairfield County CT's Best Blues Performer and resident of Newtown; Suzanne M. Sheridan (vocals and guitar), songwriter ("90 Pound Suburban Housewife Driving in Her SUV"), singer, photographer, and workshop leader and a resident of Westport; and Ed Thompson (keyboards) arranger, composer, conductor, and music educator and a resident of Norwalk. According to the group, "If our music can help promote hope and inspire faith in the possibilities of a better tomorrow, then we believe we are doing our part to make the world a better place. We're also honored that the library has asked us to help them celebrate at
