#### **Wilton Library's Summer Music & More Concert Series begins July 9**

Wilton, CT – The courtyards of Wilton Library once again come alive with music when the Summer Music & More Concert Series begins its ninth year on Thursday evenings in July, from 5 – 6:30 p.m. The Village Market is sponsoring this annual event for the ninth straight year. The series opens with the return of Steve D'Agostino and his "Singin' and Swingin'" trio performing songs from the Great American Songbook, evoking the style of the Rat Pack on July 9. Steve has been performing for more than 20 years with emphasis on songs from the era when Frank Sinatra, Dean Martin, Bobby Darin and Tony Bennett reigned supreme. Steve is from Trumbull and his "day job" keeps him in Wilton.

The series continues on July 16 with the Airborne Jazz Trio from New Haven performing a collection of jazz standards from the great jazz legends of yesterday and today. The trio consists of Thomas Sansone—sax, flute and vocals, Greg Borino—guitars and vocals, and Thomas Borino— piano, keyboards and vocals. The band has toured and performed at jazz festivals, music performance venues, colleges, and jazz clubs in the USA, Europe, and Japan.

On July 23, a local legend and former Wiltonian Jeff Harding returns to the library to perform his blend of acoustic rock. Jeff has been enjoying the sunshine and the music scene in South Florida. While making his way up the East Coast this summer, he has decided to stop and play for his hometown crowd.

The series wraps up with In Harmony, a vivacious singing group from Danbury making its second appearance at the library on July 30. The finger-snapping, toe tapping group gets the crowd moving with its contagious renditions of oldies. Members include Dee Heavrin (vocals) and Robin Miller (vocals) both of Danbury; Adrienne Lisko (vocals), Naugatuck/Waterbury; Scott Poarch (bass/baritone), Newtown; Peter Randazzo (vocals and keyboard), Trumbull; and
