Connecticut's Own Series features Amore Trio at Wilton Library May 4

Wilton, CT – The final performance of this season's Connecticut's Own Concert Series at Wilton Library features the Amore Trio on Sunday, May 4, from 4 – 5 p.m. The Amore Trio, consisting of violin, cello and piano, chose their name because of their love of music. Founded in 2002, the group seeks to bring the beauty of the great composers to Connecticut residents in a variety of settings from academic institutions such as libraries and other public forums, to retirement communities. The Trio's program will include selections from Bach, Beethoven, Brahms, Mendelssohn and Mozart.

The featured performers are:

- **Henry Mohrer**, piano, began his studies in Germany at age seven with Bernard Sekles, director of the Frankfurt Conservatory. He continued his training in the U.S, with P. Kwalwasser in Syracuse, N.Y. and in New York with Harold Bogin. He is a graduate engineer and has, since his 'teens, performed with many orchestras both classical and swing. In recent years he has concentrated on the chamber music repertoire. He lives in Orange, CT.
- **Celia Weil**, violin, is a graduate of Mannes College of Music where she studied with Robert Gerle. She has been a member of the symphony orchestras of New Orleans, Buffalo and Dallas. Her current emphasis is on chamber music, as well as serving as a member of the Bridgeport Orchestra. She lives in Stratford, CT.
- **Charlotte Moulyn**, cello, graduated from the Mannes College of Music and received a masters in performance from Yale University. She was awarded a Ford Foundation grant to participate in a Pablo Casals master class in Puerto Rico. She has been a member of the Syracuse and New Orleans orchestras. Ms. Moulyn is currently a member of the Connecticut Chamber, Bridgeport and Wallingford orchestras. She also teaches at the MACH, Waltersville and Munoz-Marin schools. Charlotte also lives in Stratford.
