Return performance for Shiller and Gurevich at Wilton Library's Connecticut's Own concert March 20

Wilton, CT – This month's Connecticut's Own concert at Wilton Library is headlined by returning performers Larry Shiller on violin and Olga Gurevich on piano Sunday, March 20 at 4 p.m. The hour-long concert features pieces by Beethoven, Brahms and Ravel.

A Wilton resident, Larry Shiller has performed previously in the Connecticut's Own series with the Quadrivium String Quartet and with Ms. Gurevich. He has also played with the Toledo Symphony, Miami Chamber Symphony, Ft. Lauderdale Philharmonic, Princeton Symphony, Greenwich Symphony, and was concertmaster of the New York Philharmonic and Westminster Conservatory Orchestra. He is the founder of ShillerMath and the talk show host for Unconventional Wisdom Radio on Cox Radio.

Olga Gurevich earned her Ph.D. in Music at Moscow State Academy. She has performed in Russia, Belarus, Germany, Italy, Portugal, and elsewhere. Olga was a winner of international piano competitions in Salerno, Italy in 1995 and Ibla, Italy in 1996. Along with performing, Olga taught piano at the Music Faculty of the Moscow State Academy. In 1998 Olga moved to New York, continuing her performing and teaching careers. Currently, she is concentrating on playing chamber music repertoire in various chamber music ensembles.

The Connecticut's Own concert series is free. Reservations are highly recommended due to the popularity of the series. Registered attendees are reminded to arrive by 3:50 p.m. to be guaranteed seating. Waitlisted and walk-in registrants will be seated after 3:50 p.m. if space is available. The next performances in the series are pianist Ron Hawkins playing Bach's *The Well-Tempered Clavier, Book I Preludes* in its entirety on May 22 and The Schubert Club of Fairfield Country performing in concert June 5 to celebrate their centennial.
