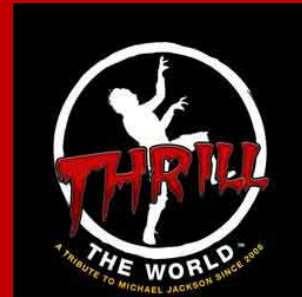
Rehearsal dates:
