## **Wilton Library's Summer Music Concert Series Begins on July 9** ***Weekly concerts take place on Thursday evenings in July,*** ***with pop-rock trio Over Easy kicking off the series***

Wilton, Conn. – June 18, 2026 – Wilton Library is pleased to announce the return of its annual Summer Music Concert Series. The opening concert featuring the Fairfield County-based pop-rock trio **Over Easy** takes place on Thursday, July 9, from 5 to 6:30 p.m. The concerts will continue throughout the month of July on Thursday evenings, July 16, 23 and 30, from 5 to 6:30 p.m. with live performances that feature music spanning all decades from the '40s on. For the twenty-fourth year, Village Market is sponsoring the library's four-part concert series.

Kicking off the library's concert series on July 9 is the popular trio **Over Easy**, covering music from the '50s, the British Invasion era, and early '70s classics that are often forgotten. Over Easy was founded by bass player and singer Steve Cinque from Stratford. Former Drummer Jim Zembruski, formerly of Easton, joined the group and recommended singer, pianist, and guitarist Mark Holleran from Trumbull, who was an old high school friend. Jim has since moved to Maine, and is replaced by Barry Urich. The musicians receive rave reviews for their ability to cater their sound to their listeners and their fun, laid-back style that invites audience participation.

Next, **Sounds of Sinatra** performs on July 16 at the library. Sounds of Sinatra features an exceptional group of professional musicians working with highly renowned tribute artists, paying homage to the legendary Frank Sinatra with songs and stories that present a musical journey through the career of the iconic performer. Sounds of Sinatra

Music features Sinatra Tribute Artist Jesse Posa, Band Leader Tony Traina on drums, Musical Director Christian Martirano on keyboard, and Arranger Keith Gurland on woodwinds. This show is sure to be a crowd-pleaser.

**Captain Obvious** returns to the library to perform on July 23. Captain Obvious is a well-known local all-star cover band featuring Wilton's Andy Schlesinger, John Taylor, Dan Berg, Mike Oliver and Dave Valle. These Wilton Rocks for Food favorites will play a set of recognizable popular songs designed to have everyone dancing and singing along. Long time veterans of the local music scene, the band has played together since 2015. Come enjoy some great music by local talent!

The finale of the concert series on July 30 features the band **Everything Else**. Everything Else enjoys playing the music that comes from their hearts – British and American hits of the British Invasion years, 1964-1969 (Beatles, Beach Boys, Bee Gees, Monkees, and many more). Prepare to be transported back in time to the '60s and early '70s with hits from Ed Sullivan to Woodstock and beyond. Everything Else features Cliff Chapin, lead vocals and guitar; Pat Falciano, lead vocals and keyboard; Joe Karlik, lead guitar; Cary Marks, vocals and bass; Tim O'Leary, drums; Wayne Tucker, lead vocals, rhythm guitar, and percussion; and Andy Kinsey, sound engineer.

Thanks to the Village Market, the concerts are free and open to the public, with free snacks and refreshments. Refreshments are generously donated by Janet and Michael Crystal. The concerts take place rain or shine in the Brubeck Room. Concertgoers are invited to sit indoors or enjoy lovely summer evenings in the Courtyard with the bands in full view. There is no registration required; first come, first served. Attendees can pop in for a few minutes or stay and appreciate the full performances.
