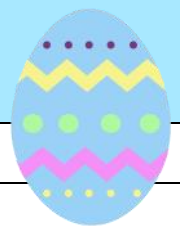
Our drive-thru window is open Mondays through Fridays, 10 - 6, Saturdays, 10 - 5; closed Sundays

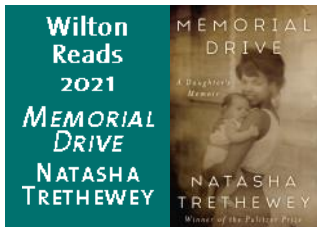
