eBooks are books that can be checked out and downloaded to your mobile device or computer..

What are eAudiobooks?

eAudiobooks are audiobooks that can be checked out and downloaded to your mobile device or computer.

What are eMagazines?

eMagazines are full copies of magazines that can be checked out and downloaded to your mobile device or viewed on a computer.

Who can check out eBooks, eAudiobooks, and eMagazines from the Wilton Library?

Wilton residents with a valid Wilton Library card.

Why do we have two different apps for eBooks and eAudiobooks?

OverDrive and RB Digital offer different titles. To have the most comprehensive collections, we provide access to both services.

How many eBooks and eAudiobooks can I check out?

You can check out up to 10 eBooks or Audiobooks in both OverDrive and RB Digital.

What is the lending period for eBooks and eAudiobooks?

You may borrow eBooks and eAudiobooks for 21 days.

How many hold can I place on eBooks and eAudiobooks?

You may place up to 10 holds in both OverDrive and RB Digital.

How are eMagazines different than reading articles in a library database?

When you check out an eMagazine, you can read it from cover to cover. Some of the magazines include web links or interactive audio or video.

How many eMagazines can I check out?

You can check out all of our eMagazines.

What is the lending period for eMagazines?

You can keep eMagazines for as long as you wish.

How many hold can I place on eMagazines?

You never need to place a hold on an eMagazine. All magazines are always available.
